Many former foster kids have a difficult time with the abrupt changes related to aging out care. They're less likely to find a job, go to college, or even find a place to sleep every night. Imagine asking yourself the following questions, "What happened when I left the foster care system? What made a difference for me? What might have helped? Who supported and guided me when I aged out?" Hope's Path bridges the gap in services and builds supportive networks so that our interns can answer each of these questions with confidence, courage, and a resilient spirit to succeed.

A key feature of our program and an ongoing program need is recognizing how vehicle ownership will assist our interns. Chris is a skilled glass installer for homes and businesses. In May 2022, he approached the staff with a detailed plan to purchase a 2007 Ford F-150 from Hope's Path. He stated that he had always wanted to own a truck and that this financial commitment would help him build upon his dream of expanding his own glass installation business, Windows Galore & More. Our support helped him feel empowered and we are so proud of his entrepreneur dreams. On July 22, 2022, Chris made his final payment the Hope's Path vehicle program. is an incredible thing to witness when a young man can answer the questions above with a smile on his face and is feeling proud for accomplishing a specific goal and optimistic about his future.
