I have improved way more by being here rather than being on my own. People here have saved thousands of dollars and are well off in their careers, such as cybersecurity or a career in the medical field. Hope's Path gives you "Hope" to accomplish anything. As always, with God, anything is possible. It's a true blessing to be at Hope's Path."
