Program Happenings and Updates

Prairie View A&M Collaborative Partnership

The Social Work Department and MSW Program at Prairie View A&M University have partnered with Hope's Path to provide field education to students. This partnership offers graduate students a learning experience that teaches practice-based skills. Field education is the social work pedagogy, enabling students to connect classroom theory with hands-on training in professional settings. Dr. Beverly Spears, Interim MSW Field Director, states, "Collaborating with social service, mental and health agencies, and nonprofit organizations is valuable; it helps prepare us to prepare our MSW students in learning to work effectively with clients." This partnership helps better prepare the next generation of social workers. Over the last several months, MSW student Ciara Torrance has interned at Hope's Path. She shares her experience:

"My internship at Hope's Path has given me insight into nonprofit organizations. In my first year as a social work student, I developed important communication, collaboration, and networking skills. It exposed

me to diverse client backgrounds, case management, and advocacy for disadvantaged populations. I was also allowed to participate in professional development opportunities such as seminars, conferences, and educational training workshops that I will continue applying in my social work profession."
