Volunteer Highlight: Melanie Labardini

Melanie Labardini is a Mental Health Counselor in the Spring/Woodlands area who has been connected with Hope's Path since 2017, but her journey began a couple of years earlier. In 2015, Melanie's youngest daughter, Karissa, died by suicide. Melanie was eventually diagnosed with PTSD as a result of her death, as were others within her family.

Shortly after Karissa's death, Melanie accepted a volunteer staff position at Northside Christian Church as their Local Missions Director. Also, she began to sit alongside others



who were experiencing grief and anxiety, including leading GriefShare at the church. As Local Missions Director, she began to work with Hope's Path in various ways. She coordinated volunteers and supported in multiple capacities, organized Christmas gifts for the interns and staff, and arranged to have much-needed supplies delivered during the early days of COVID-19. Over time, Melanie became more and more aware of the impacts of trauma on the body, mind, and lives of herself and others, and decided to go back to school for her Masters in Clinical Mental Health Counseling.

True to her passion for healing trauma, Melanie started her counseling career at Montgomery County Women's Center, a non-profit focused primarily on survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault. She also sought specialized training in trauma and ways to treat it, including EMDR and Brainspotting. As of October of 2023, Melanie has moved to work at her private practice, Feather Wing Counseling, named after a verse that has buoyed her throughout her own grief and trauma journey, Psalm 91:4. Her greatest passions are working with individuals who have survived ongoing childhood abuse and neglect of all types, single incident traumas, traumatic grief, and anxiety.

Melanie no longer holds a volunteer staff position at Northside, as her volunteer work has moved more towards using her counseling skills. She now functions as an on-call consultant for Hope's Path, troubleshooting challenges and helping them better understand trauma and its impacts within the organization. Melanie also provides no-cost individual counseling to one of the interns, with plans to expand to others. Finally, she gives back to the community by delivering sliding-scale services to some of her clients.
