Kim is one of our incredible volunteers at Hope's Path. We asked her to share her experience; this is her story...

"If you had told 29-year-old me that moved to the Houston area in 2004, homeless, jobless, carless, and with a two 1/2-month-old baby fleeing a domestic violence situation (where my partner was heavily addicted to methamphetamines) scared to death, that I would be in the position I am today with the ability to share and give back, I don't know that I would have believed you. The only thing I can say is Because of GOD and the love and support of family and friends who prayed over me and poured

into me at a time when I so desperately needed it. Also, the support and counseling services of the NAM Family Violence Center helped immensely.

I enjoy speaking with the young men, learning their stories as I prepare meals for them, and just showing up. Time is so simple but is priceless and can also mean so much to someone who has had struggles that none of us may even know about. I know I probably don't even know half of what some have experienced. Still, my hope is I can provide some consistency and pour some love over them through my cooking and conversations, which not only is hopefully a blessing for them but a huge blessing for me, as I earn their trust, earn a hug, etc. as I get to know them and learn what they feel comfortable sharing with me. Again, all of this is possible Because of GOD and his many blessings.

I began cooking at Hope's Path right after it first opened in 2017 with the make-a-meal program for a couple

of years, and now I have been blessed with the opportunity again. I am so thankful for receiving that newsletter earlier this year and reaching out. I am grateful that Barbara contacted me and coordinated a meeting with Brandon. I am thankful for the fellowship that has ensued since I started volunteering at Hope's Path again with the interns, staff, and other volunteers I have been blessed to meet through this experience. Furthermore, Because of GOD! I do not doubt that HIS hand orchestrated this opportunity for me in 2017 and now."
